Alan J. Kessler passed away on Thursday, February 18, 2021 in Mt. Clemens, Michigan. Alan was born on December 14, 1944 in Detroit, Michigan to Lawrence and Eleanor Kessler. Alan proudly served his country in the US Army during the Vietnam War where he was awarded the National Defense Service Medal, the Marksman Medal for the M-14, the Vietnam Service Medal, the Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal Ribbon with Device, as well as the Good Conduct Medal. Upon being discharged from the Army as a SP5 Alan continued his life of service by joining the Warren Fire Department. Alan served in that roll until he retired in 1996 as a Lieutenant after 25 years of service. Alan is the beloved husband of 50 years to Darlene. Loving father of Tammy (Barry) York, Michelle (Matt) Hoch, and Tracy (David) Genova. Proud grandpa of Ryan and Nicholas York and Samantha Hoch.
