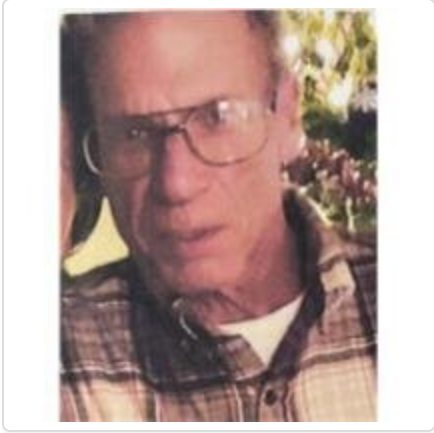




Michael R Bown
