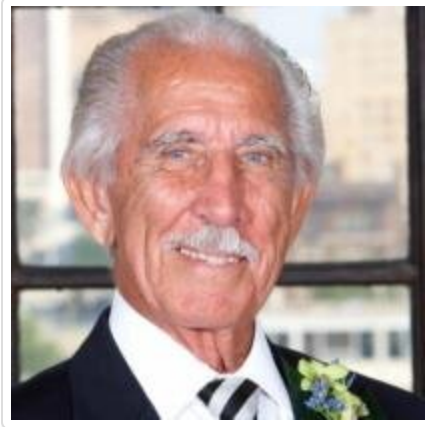




Robert A. Krall
