He enjoyed travelling, going on adventures, and trying new things. In November of '23, Kelly and Terry were able to take a vacation in New Orleans for Kelly's birthday, a trip that they had so much fun and created cherished memories on. But when he did take time to relax, he loved listening to Punk & Rock music and treasured being around his K-9 companions. From an early age, Terry had a special bond with dogs; from his childhood dog Budweiser, to his special buddy Vinnie, and now Baxter, dogs always had a special place in his heart. Kelly recalls a story where Terry was having a medical issue in the middle of the night and her dog Hershey feverishly woke her up to let her know Terry needed her assistance, undoubtedly a personification of the unconditional love shared between Terry and his beloved dogs.
